### **MOTION #C-2016-01-18-03 - Committee Appointment**

### **MOTION #C-2016-01-18-04 - Committee Appointment**

It was moved by Councillor Hudson, seconded by Councillor Paquette to appoint Alan Melanson to the Marketing and Economic Developing Committee (MEDC) for a term ending December 2016. Motion carried.

### **MOTION #C-2016-01-18-05 - Committee Appointment**

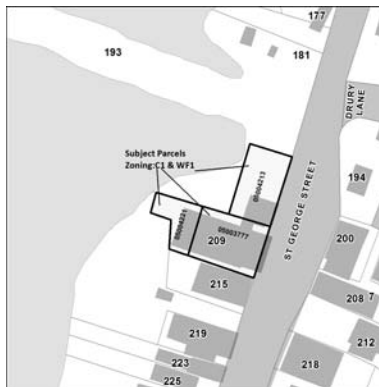

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Annapolis Royal Town Council will hold a Public Hearing in the Council Chambers of the Annapolis Royal Town Hall, at 6:00 p.m., March 9, 2016. The purpose of this Public Hearing is to receive comment from the public on its intentions to enter into development agreements with the following:

1. To enter into a development agreement with King's Theatre Society and Annapolis Royal Wharf Association to permit the construction of an accessory structure (deck) on portions of PID 05003769 and PID 05004213.



2. To enter into a development agreement with Daniel and Krista McClair to permit the construction of a dwelling unit in an existing accessory structure at 438 St George Street (PID 05002126).
