PHMC Millett-Campbell advised there would be a report next month on the progress of the items.

8. Business Arising:

a) Heritage Property Act and Regulations for Heritage Conservation Districts
The Committee would like to have a separate meeting to discuss the proposed changes in detail. PHMC Millett-Campbell will send out two dates available for the Committee to and have the discussion before the end of May.

b) Mayor Tompkins update on motion sent to Council regarding windows

Discussion was held on the direction Council would like to see the Planning and Heritage Advisory Committee move in. Mayor Tompkins advised the Committee that the last motion on the mandatory wooden windows was defeated at Council. Mayor Tompkins would like to see the Committee work on a tiered system for the heritage process instead of the current blanket system in place, the value of an educational process for the residents, contractors, and realtors in Town, and public input on the process. Alan Melanson commented that houses need to be lived in. There needs to be a balance between the heritage of the Town and living in the Town. Planning and Heritage Committee wants to conserve the heritage of the Town and the heritage district in Annapolis Royal. Mayor Tompkins suggested that the Committee review the guidelines and make a proposal to Council. The Committee decided to bring forward some ideas to the next meeting on how to get the message across to the public about our heritage values and significance of the Town's built heritage.

9. New Business:

a) AR15-009-HER – 324 St George Street – Request for Changes to a Heritage Property – Sign permit

PHMC Millett-Campbell reviewed the application received for the sign permit.

c) AR15-010-HER – 209 St George Street – Request for Changes to a Heritage Property

PHMC Millett-Campbell reviewed the application received from King's Theatre. Shawn Oliver was also in attendance to answer any questions that the Committee had.

d) AR15-011-HER – 393 St George Street – Request for Changes to a Heritage Property

PHMC Millett-Campbell reviewed the application. Jim McGinis showed the colour sample that will be used to complete the steeple portions of the roof.
