PARADE GUIDELINES

Natal Days is almost here, the theme for 2018 is “Diversity is our Strength”. There is so much you can do with this theme! Use your imagination to build a float or decorate a vehicle. Have fun, be creative and we’ll see you on parade day!

We look forward to participation by you, your family and staff along with neighbouring communities whose support adds great measures to the community spirit.

This year, the Parade will be held on Monday, August 6, 2018. The parade will form up along Champlain Drive, School Street, and in the parking lot of the County Municipal Office Building. It will then begin at the corner of St. George Street and School Street, proceed north on St. George Street, turn east on St. Anthony Street, then north on Drury Lane and east back onto St. George Street to the first entrance of Fort Anne. The parade will end at the Fort where final judging and awarding of prizes will take place.

All entries will be registered at the Parade Marshal’s desk in front of the Baptist Church at the corner of St. George St. and St. Patrick’s Lane. Assistant Marshal’s will direct entries to their place in the parade line-up.

Please register between 10:00 am and 12:00 pm. (Washrooms are available in the hall of the Baptist Church). The parade will begin at 1:00pm.

For reasons of safety, children under the age of ten years must be accompanied by an adult.

Please do not throw candy or other favors from floats or vehicles. If you wish to distribute favors, you can do so by having persons walk alongside your entry.

Keep approx 10 metres (30 feet) behind the entry in front of you.

All vehicles and trailers must be registered and insured in compliance with the Motor Vehicle Act.

Float dimensions should be less than 39 feet in length, 8 feet in width and 12 feet in height. Entries larger than this require written approval by the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation. (Hint don’t do it)

All operators of ATV’s must wear helmets and remain in the parade line up. Freewheeling outside the assigned position in the parade column is illegal. A Police Escort will be provided at the end of the parade to return riders to their vehicles.

All drivers must remain with vehicle entries from the time of arrival at the marshalling site until completion of the judging at Fort Anne. All drivers must comply with the directions given to them by the Parade Marshal (identifiable by orange safety vests) or by the Annapolis Royal Police Department. At Fort Anne, Parks Canada Staff members will marshal entries for the awarding of prizes.

The Parade Marshal, and Chief of Police have the authority to deny entry or remove any participant from the parade if they judge the entry to present a safety hazard to themselves or the general public. Persons riding or driving horses should have sufficient experience and maturity to be able to handle their charges in the confusion and excitement of a parade.

It is the responsibility and liability of the applicant to ensure the safety of other entrants and other users. Please enjoy yourself. Please be safety conscious.
