

### The Great Annapolis Royal Scavenger Hunt

The Journey to become an Honorary Annapolitan Extraordinaire is not easy. It takes cleverness and a bit of walking. Decipher each of the riddles, visit the sites, and find the answers (all answers are numbers). Then complete the arithmetic. Each answer will correspond to a letter in the table at the bottom. One final clue, you may want to answer the first part of each riddle to plan your route. (Googling is allowed!)

Use these letters to solve the Final Riddle and claim your prize!

1. I was the first black female mayor in Canada, elected in 1984. I am also a descendent of the famous Rose Fortune. Add up the digits in the year my memorial was sculpted \_\_\_\_\_. Multiply this number by 2 and subtract 3. Final answer \_\_\_\_\_
2. I was a business woman as well as the first female police officer in Canada. How many vertical steel bars are part of my monument in the graveyard? \_\_\_\_\_. Add 12 to this number and subtract 10. Final answer \_\_\_\_\_
3. I am the tallest monument in the graveyard. How many letters in the family name inscribed on me? \_\_\_\_\_. Divide this number by 2 and add 7. Final answer \_\_\_\_\_.
4. I am the second oldest wooden structure in Canada. How many ghosts live in my basement? \_\_\_\_\_. Divide this answer by 2 and add 19. Final answer \_\_\_\_\_
5. I was built to remember the coming together of the M'ikmaq of L'sitkuk and the citizens of the town of Annapolis Royal. How many boats are shown in the petroglyph depicted on my informational sign? \_\_\_\_\_. Divide this number by 2 and add 21. Final answer \_\_\_\_\_
6. I was built in 1629 to protect the harbour. In 1917, I became a national historic park. How many (fake) soldiers guard my doors? \_\_\_\_\_. Multiply this number by 6 and add 2. Final answer \_\_\_\_\_
7. I am a 17-acre horticultural paradise with the only authenticated replica of a pre-deportation Acadian dwelling. I am guarded by 2 giant (metal) birds. How many feathers on their heads? (total) \_\_\_\_\_. Multiply this answer by 3 and divide by 2. Final answer \_\_\_\_\_
8. I am the centre of our local government. Add up the digits in the year my cornerstone was laid? \_\_\_\_\_. Multiply this answer by 2 and subtract 7. Final answer \_\_\_\_\_
9. In 1604, I organized the expedition which led to the establishment of Port Royal. On my monument, how many men are in the row boats? \_\_\_\_\_. Add 17 to this number and subtract 8. Final answer \_\_\_\_\_

10. Boats visit me when they need a bit of repair. Add up the digits of the year I was rebuilt \_\_\_\_\_. Multiply this answer by 4 and subtract 11. Final answer \_\_\_\_\_
11. I will lead you along the water. How many solar "lighthouses" show you the way? \_\_\_\_\_. Add 29 to this number and subtract 24. Final answer \_\_\_\_\_
12. I was once home to a Nova Scotia Pony Express rider but am now a museum. How many sets of windows are on my northern end? \_\_\_\_\_ Divide this answer by 2 and subtract 3. Final answer \_\_\_\_\_
