  - Mr. Millier provided an overview of the housekeeping amendments that are needed to the MPS and LUB. It was noted that many Committee and staff members looked over the large document and missed minor errors. The amendments do not change the intent of the MPS and LUB as it is mostly grammar errors. Specifically, there are 25 proposed amendments to the MPS text, 10 proposed amendments to the MPS generalized future land use map, 11 text of the LUB, 13 companion amendments to the LUB zoning map and heritage property map, and 1 change of a LUB definition. Mr. Millier thanked everyone involved in the process of developing and assisting with the housekeeping amendments of the MPS and LUB.
