



VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY

The Annapolis Royal Police Service is recruiting to fill vacancies with the Auxiliary Constable Unit. The Auxiliary Police Program is a volunteer program, intended to enhance community-based policing by providing an opportunity for citizens to participate and volunteer with Law Enforcement on an organized basis.

Auxiliary Police members will provide complementary service to sworn police officers by assisting officers while under constant supervision.

Individuals that are accepted will receive orientation and mandatory training that will enable them to perform their duties.

Basic Requirements

- Canadian Citizen or Permanent resident of Canada
- Be at least 19 years of age
- Grade 12 or equivalent
- Possess a valid First Aid CPR Certificate (or able to engage in a class within 6 month of hire)
- Possess a valid Driver's License (Unrestricted)
- Must be capable of passing a complete medical and physical examination, if required
- No Criminal Record
- Be a good character.
- Preference will be given to applicants that reside within 30 kilometers from The Town of Annapolis Royal.

Application Process

- Initial Application (Submit the following as one package)
 - Auxiliary Constable Application form
 - Resume and Cover letter
 - 3 Professional letters of reference
 - Criminal Record check
 - Copy of Driver's License
 - And, one other form of Government ID.
- Aptitude Test
- Panel Interview
- Medical Exam (*if required*)
- Background investigation
