I have served as Mayor for the Town of Annapolis Royal since 2020 and was the Town's CAO from 2002 to 2012. During a long human resources and labour relations career, I have worked for every level of government as well as the private sector. volunteer as a fitness instructor for the Annapolis Royal Nursing Home. I would focus on the imminent loss of revenues from the grant in lieu of taxes for the Nova Scotia Power tidal plant. I have worked closely with a private company, Town staff and others to pursue new inter-tidal power technology which has the potential to generate revenue and reduce green house gas emissions at the same time. If elected, I would continue to work with others on securing funding to implement recommendations for marsh restoration and a low-barrier seawall to protect the downtown from flooding. I also support the continued use of strategic planning to manage scarce resources. I hope to work with Town Council and the CAO to build a team that will continue to raise the bar for Council, and support the staff in providing service to the public.
