POSITION SUMMARY:

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Cleaning and Maintenance
- Weekly gas dips and readings
- Check around town for debris, such as bottles, glass, broken signs, leaks, smell etc.
- Empty, repair, install and paint garbage cans
- Straighten, paint, repair and replace signs within town limits
- Paint, winterize, and shovel out fire hydrants
- Sweep and maintain streets, paint crosswalks and parking spaces
- Look after manholes, pot holes, etc.
- Wash vehicles and equipment, clean shop and office, paint and repair equipment, keep shop and equipment in safe working order etc.
- Put up, take down and repair X-mas decorations, pick up X-mas trees and put in dump
- Operate tractor, backhoe, plow truck and snow blower for the removal of snow and salting of streets and sidewalks. Note that snow removal may occur outside of standard working hours
- Fix driveways, maintain lawns, rake leaves and clean catch basins
- Assist in repairing and installing water lines and sewer lines, unclog sewers, rod and maintain sewers
- Water readings and water on/off requests
- Willingness to support with "after-hours" emergencies as required
- Willingness to obtain "Operator in Training" (OIT) certificate and train toward operator certificates for water and wastewater.

The Chlorination Plant

- Check for chlorine residual
- Keep the logbook up to date
- Clean floors and walls, paint inside & outside, deal with chlorine odours, drain storage tank, etc.

The Sewer Treatment Plant

- o Checked on a regular basis
- o Assist with putting boat in sewer lagoon to repair & clean air lines
- o Keep building clean & safe
- o Cleaning UV lights
- o Check sewer lift stations to ensure pumps are working correctly
- o Assist with pulling pumps out of station for repairs and adjustments

The Water Shed

- O Town's water shed must be checked to ensure the system is working properly. This entails keeping neat and tidy, trimming bushes, discouraging beavers etc.
- o Assist in flushing water mains
